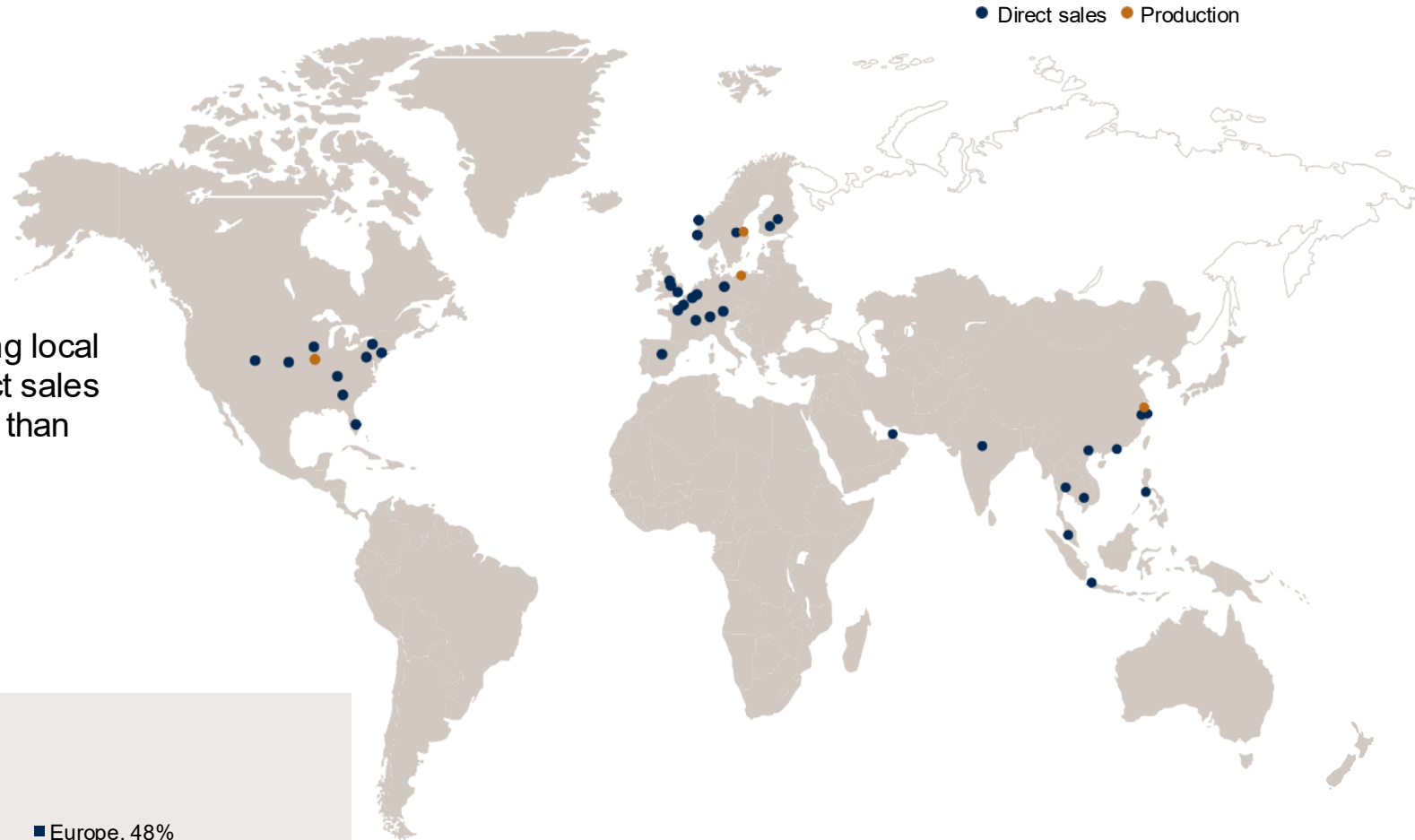

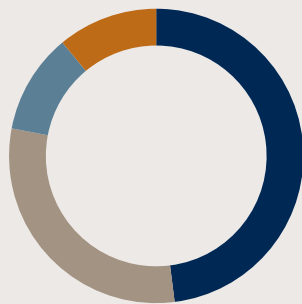

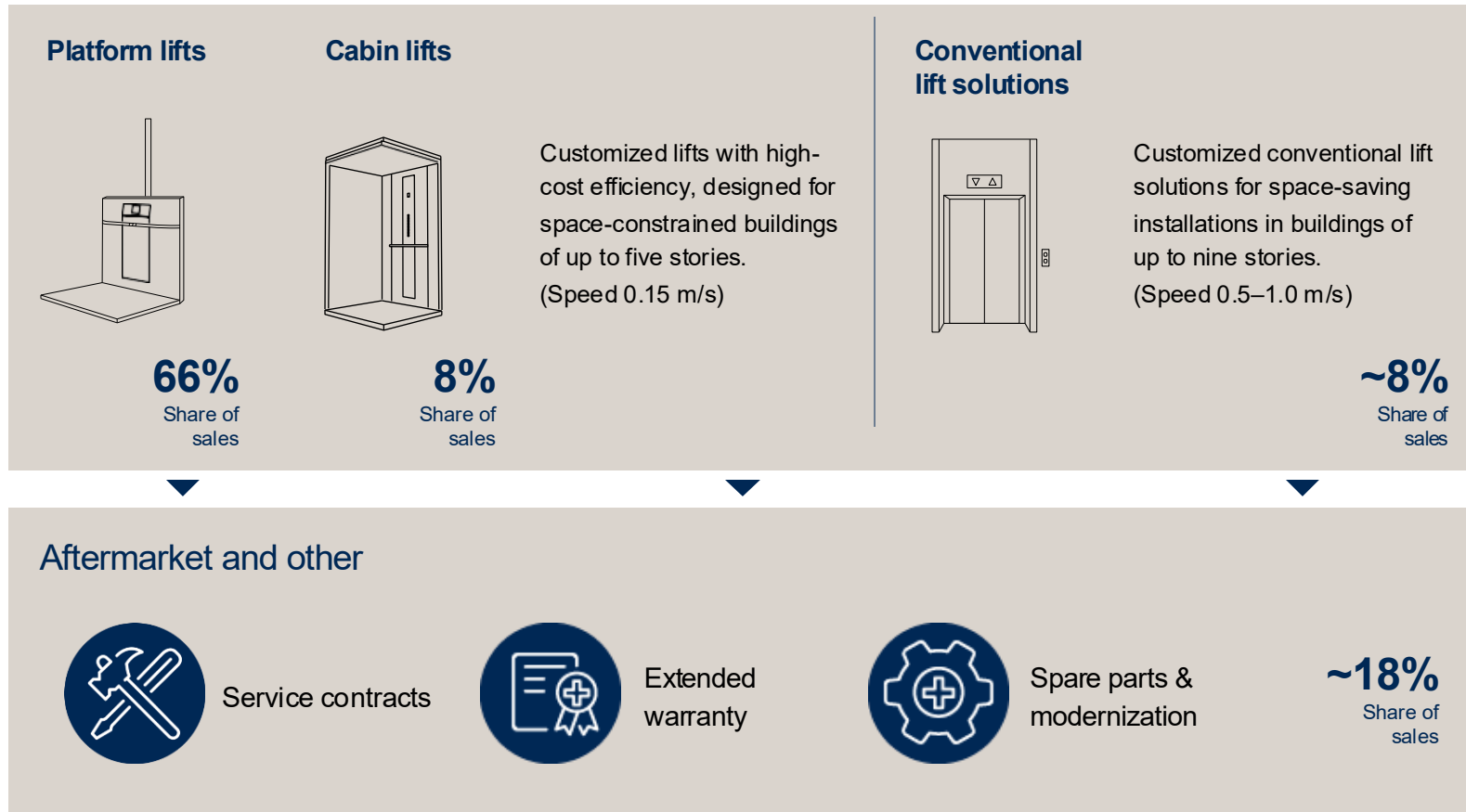

Space-efficient lift solutions

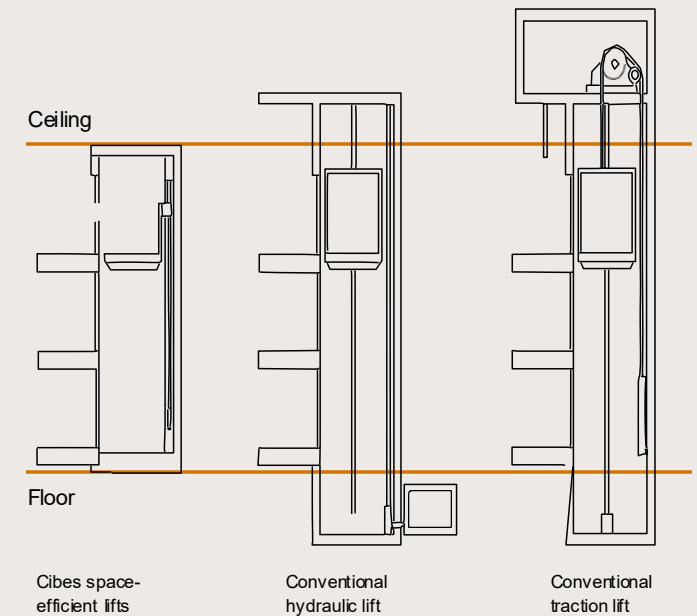
Installing Cibes lifts requires fewer and significantly smaller building adaptations compared to conventional lift solutions.



Cibes space-efficient lifts can easily be installed in a self-supporting shaft in an open atrium, in the middle of a staircase, through the floor, or outdoors directly adjacent to the building.

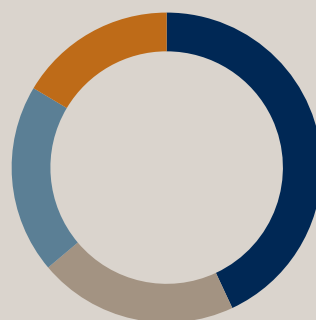

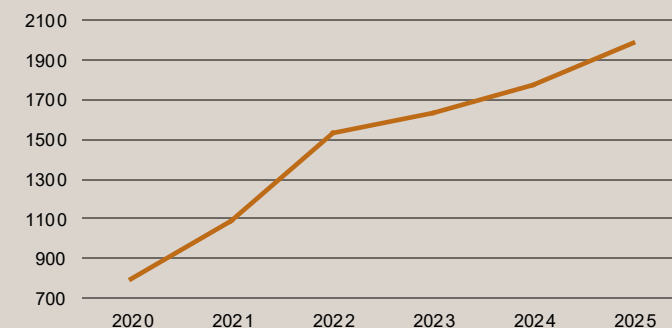
Geographic distribution of employees

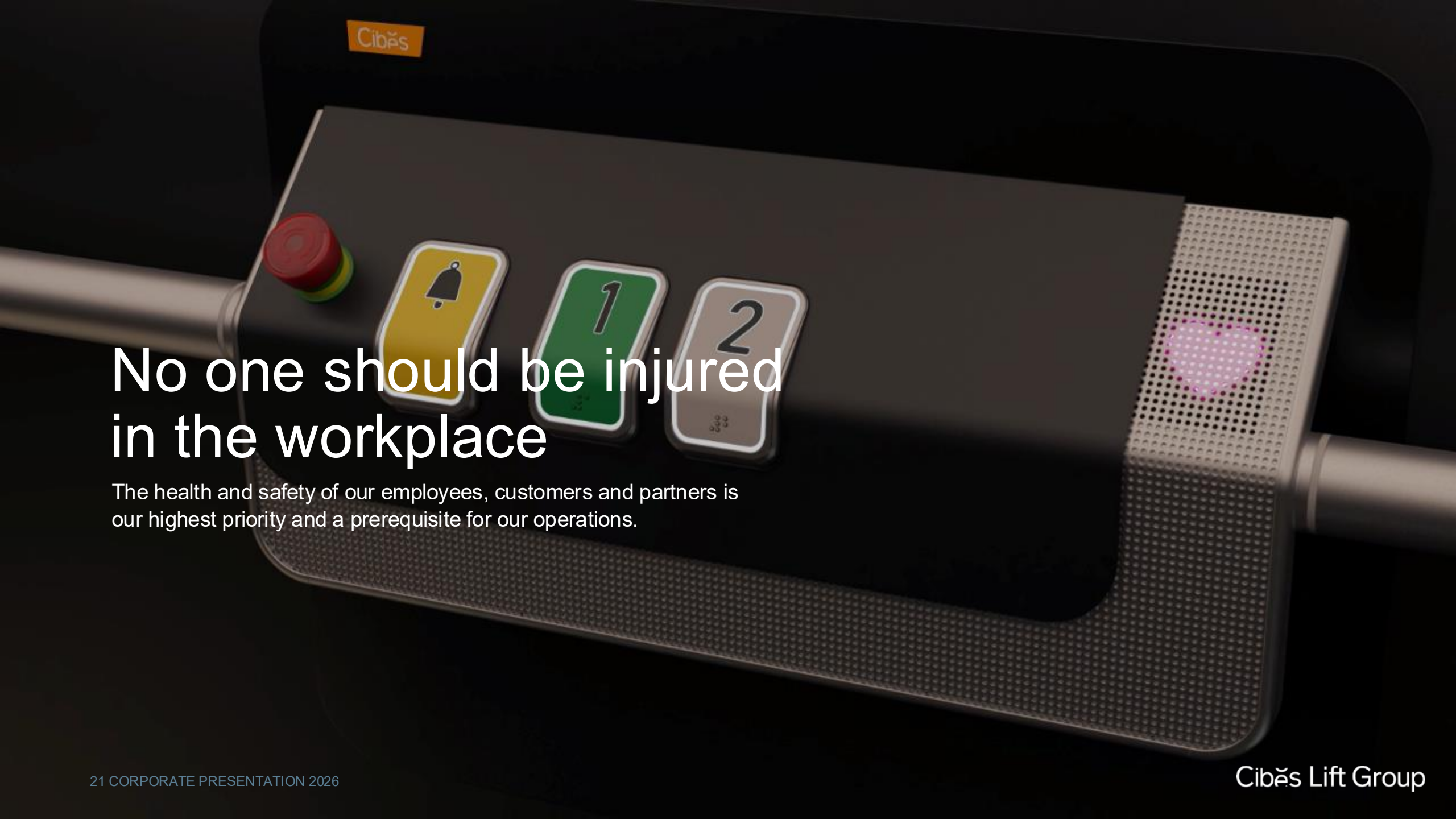

Installed lifts around the world

Modern townhouse, Shanghai, China

Ascenda is a cabin lift with a sleek and space-saving design that received an iF Design Award in 2025. Thanks to its shaft-less construction, the lift only occupies space on the floor where the cabin is located.





Restaurant, Austin, TX, USA

In this restaurant in central Austin, a Symmetry LULA lift was installed, combining accessibility with a design that blends seamlessly into the environment. The black lift enclosure, glass doors and brass details create a modern expression that complements the interior.

Historic water tower, Utrecht, Netherlands

Cibes A5000 platform lift, installed in a former water tower in Utrecht that has been converted into luxury housing. The lift is installed in a 400 m² multi-story apartment, in a site-built concrete shaft, with a fully customized door design.



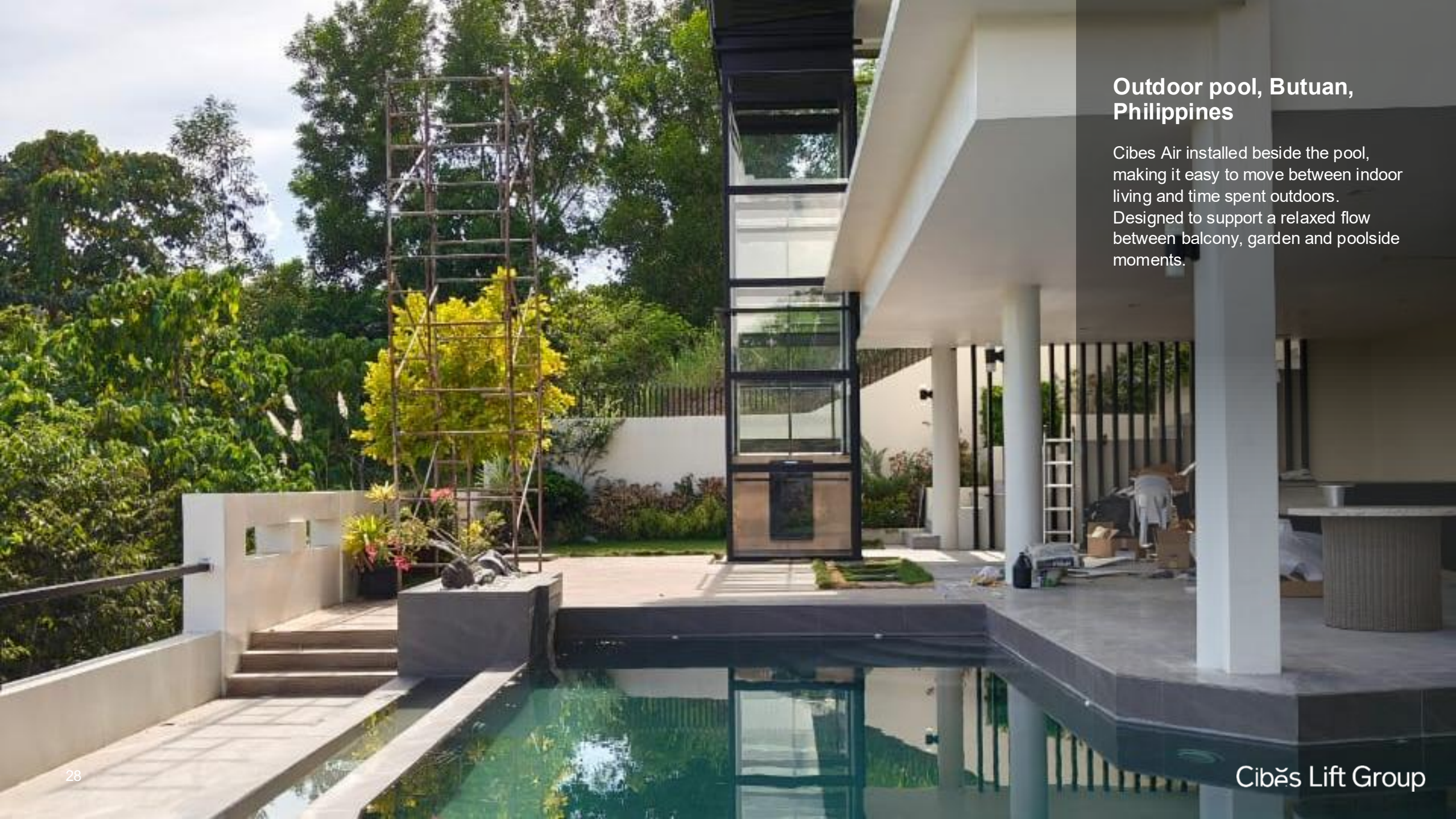

Mountain cabin, Vanoise, France

New build, Miami, FL, USA

In this newly built home in Miami, a Symmetry Asterix lift was integrated into the staircase to create a natural flow between floors.



Outdoor pool, Butuan, Philippines

Cibes Air installed beside the pool, making it easy to move between indoor living and time spent outdoors. Designed to support a relaxed flow between balcony, garden and poolside moments.

Luxury villa, Hanoi, Vietnam

Antera Z90 integrated into a private villa lift shaft, where the lifts interior echoes the home's design. Dark wood finishes and warm lighting contribute to a refined, luxurious interior expression.



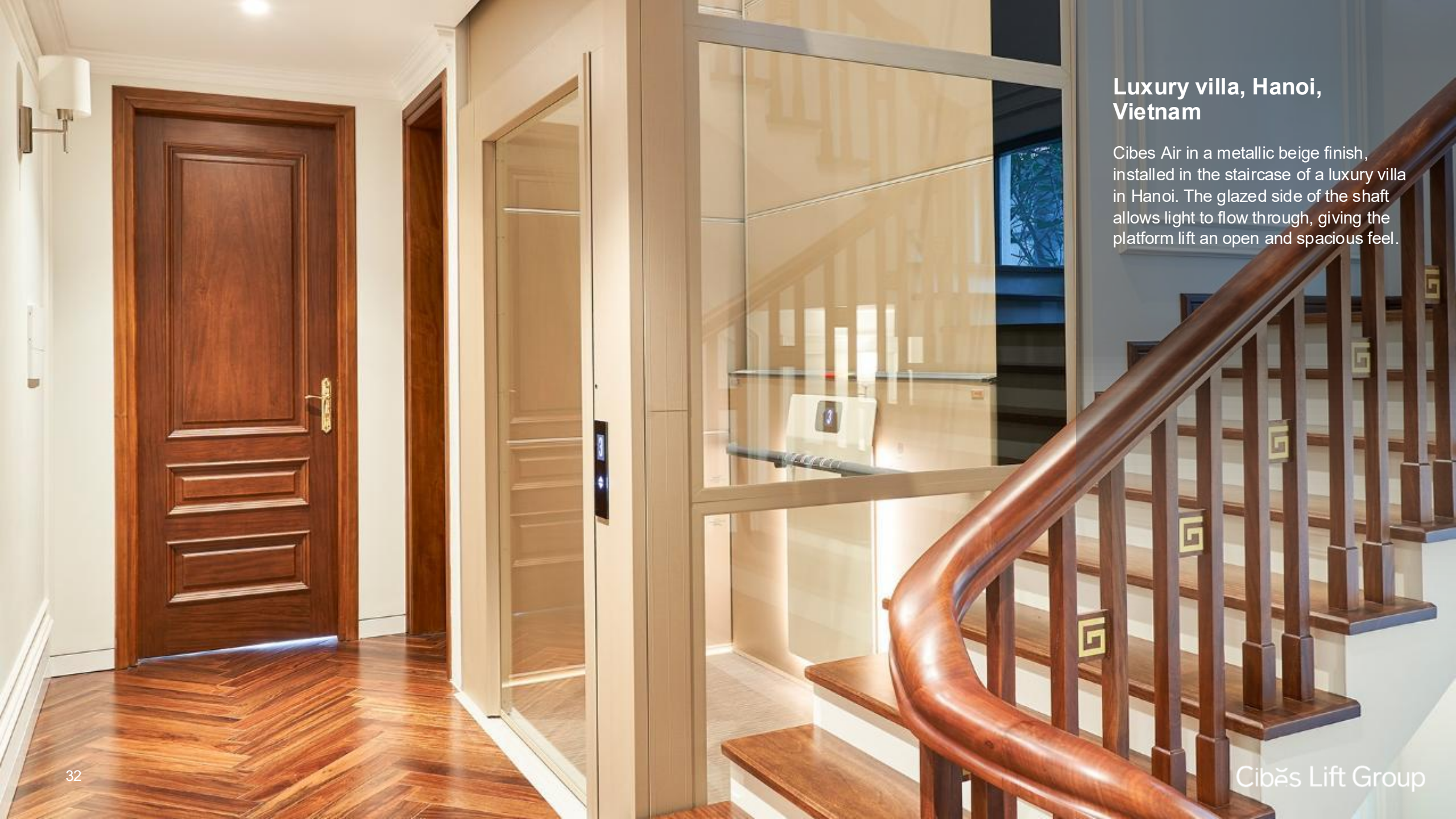
Modern luxury villa, Helsinki, Finland

Cibes Air platform lift installed in a newly built villa designed in a Scandinavian, minimalist style. The top of the shaft has been customized to perfectly align with the elegant sloping ceiling.



Office building, Stockholm, Sweden

In the lobby of the Uarda 7 office building in Solna, Stockholm, a Cibes A5000 has been installed. The platform lift is clad in natural stone, and the half-height door on the upper floor preserves the open and airy feel.



Luxury villa, Hanoi, Vietnam

Cibes Air in a metallic beige finish, installed in the staircase of a luxury villa in Hanoi. The glazed side of the shaft allows light to flow through, giving the platform lift an open and spacious feel.

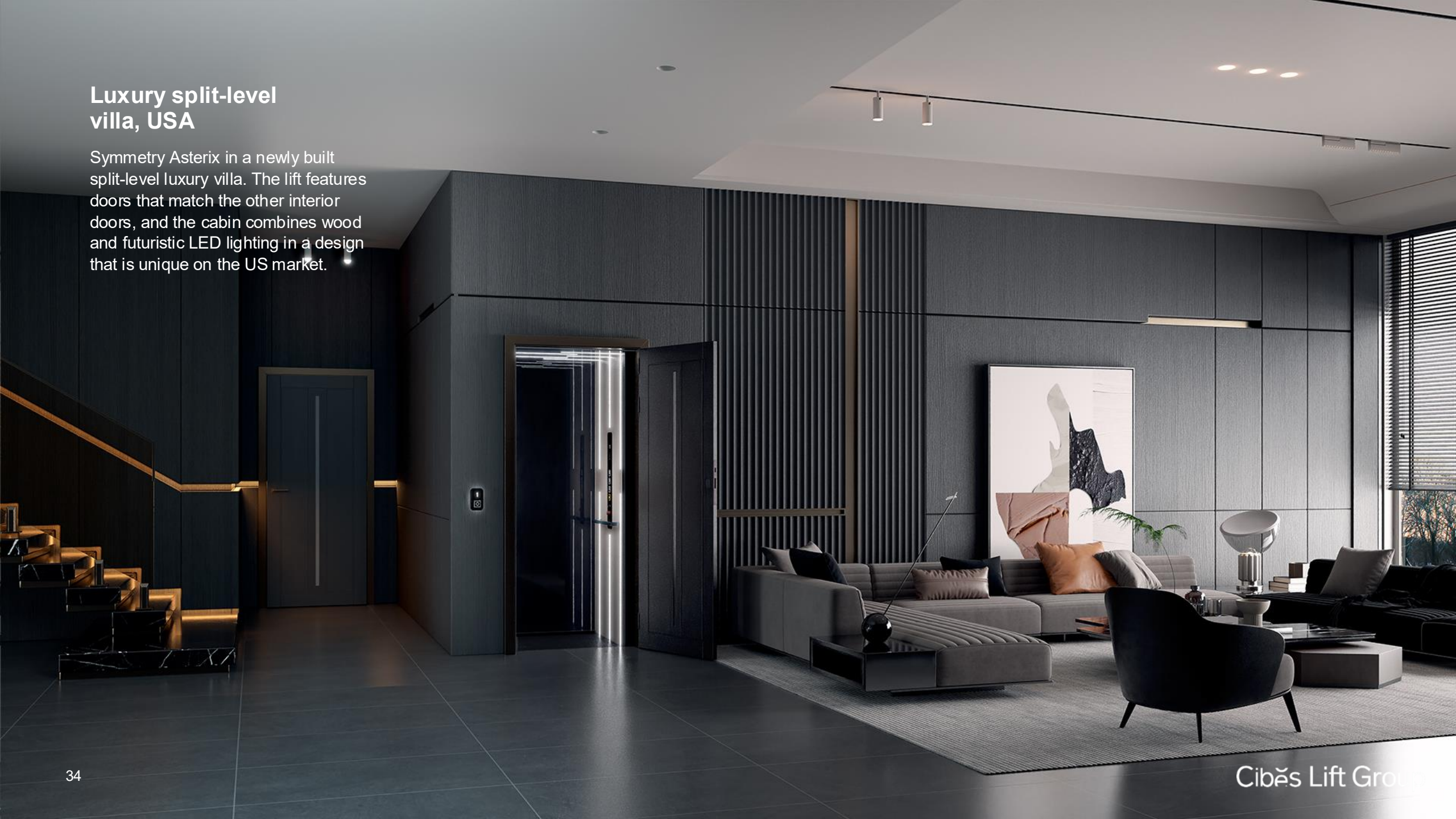
Newly built luxury villa, Helsinki, Finland

Cibes Cloud Plus installed in the staircase of a newly built villa designed in Scandinavian style with luxurious materials. The lift design has been customized to perfectly match the interior – from color selection to the elegant, space-saving saloon doors.



Luxury split-level villa, USA

Symmetry Asterix in a newly built split-level luxury villa. The lift features doors that match the other interior doors, and the cabin combines wood and futuristic LED lighting in a design that is unique on the US market.

In a church converted into a microbrewery, a Cibes A5000 was chosen to make the mezzanine level of the restaurant bar accessible. The platform lift's grey finish blends seamlessly with the loft structure, and the half-height door preserves the open and airy feel on the upper level.



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
